

# Sugar And Spice Topper

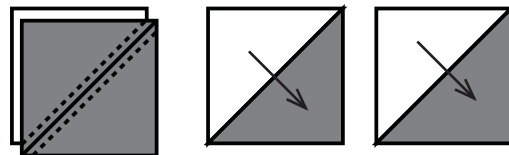


Finishes 21½" x 21½"  
 Batting - 24" square  
 Backing - 24" square.

Light	Block	2 - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" 4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	Fat Eighth
Red Tonal Print	Block	4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"	Fat Eighth
Brown Print	Block	1 - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" 2 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	1/2 yard
	Cornerstone	4 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"	
	Border #2	4 - 2" x 14 1/2"	
	Binding	3 - 2 1/4" strips	
Dark Blue Print	Block	1 - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" 2 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	Fat Eighth
Light Blue Print	Cornerstones	4 - 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" 4 - 2" x 2"	Fat Eighth
Stripe	Border #1	4 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2"	Fat Quarter
Red Print	Border #3	4 - 2 1/2" x 17 1/2"	Fat Quarter

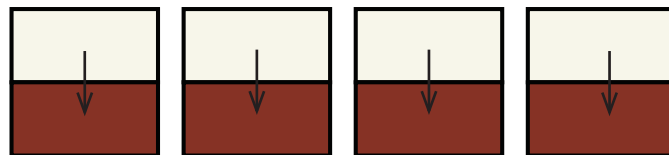
## Step 1 - Half Square Triangle Units

1. Draw a pencil line diagonally from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 4 7/8" Light Print squares.
2. Pair a 4 7/8" Light print square with a 4 7/8" Dark Blue print square right sides together and pin.
3. Sew a scant 1/4" from the drawn line. Do this on both sides of the line.
4. Cut apart on the drawn line; press to the Dark fabric.
5. Repeat steps 3 - 5 using the remaining Light Print square and the Dark Brown Print square.
6. Make two Dark Blue HST units and two Dark Brown HST units that measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



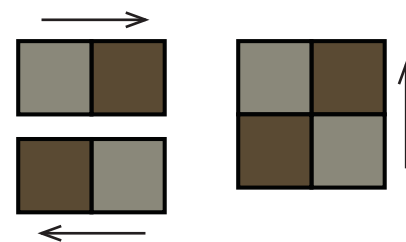
## Step 2 - Bar Units

1. Pair four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Light print rectangles right sides together with four 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Red Tonal print rectangles.
2. Sew with a scant 1/4" seam along the long edge.
3. Press toward the Red print.
4. Bar units should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



## Step 3 - Four Patch Unit

1. Pair a 2 1/2" Dark Blue print square with a 2 1/2" Dark Brown square.
2. Sew with a scant 1/4" seam along one edge.
3. Press toward the Darker fabric. Make two pairs.
4. Sew pairs together with fabrics opposite one another.
5. Press in one direction. Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



#### Step 4 - Block Assembly

1. Arrange units in order shown in Diagram 1.
2. Sew units together in rows. Diagram 2.
3. Press toward the Bar Units.
4. Sew rows together and press toward the center of the block. Diagram 3.
5. Block should measure 12 ½" x 12 ½".

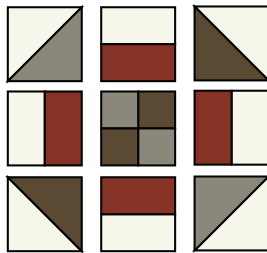

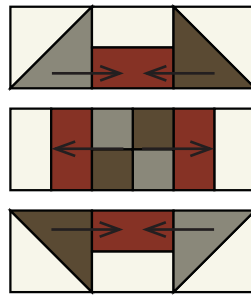

#### Step 5 - Borders

6. **Border #1** uses the **Striped** fabric. Be sure to measure the block and cut four 1 ½" strips to that length.
7. Sew a 1 ½" Dark Brown Cornerstone square to opposite ends of two of the strips. Press toward the border fabric.
8. Sew the border to the sides first, then add the units with the cornerstones. Press toward the border after each addition.
9. **Border #2** uses the **Dark Brown** fabric. Again, measure the top and cut four 2" strips to that length.
10. Sew a 2" Light Blue Cornerstone square to opposite ends of two of the strips. Press toward the border fabric.
11. Sew the border to the sides first, then add the units with the cornerstones. Press toward the border after each addition.
12. **Border #3** uses the **Red Print** fabric. Again, measure the top and cut four 2 ½" strips to that length.
13. Sew a 2 ½" Light Blue Cornerstone square to opposite ends of two of the strips. Press toward the border fabric.
14. Sew the border to the sides first, then add the units with the cornerstones. Press toward the border after each addition.
15. The topper should measure 21 ½" x 21 ½".



#### Finishing

Layer and quilt in the ditch or do a diagonal grid pattern.  
Bind and enjoy!
